Meeting Minutes

**Meeting was attended by** Bill Cousins, Scott Hackmyer, Duane Gildea, Audrey Beem, Shirley Daniel, Nancy Castillo, Milo Ayen, Manette Cheshareck, Lauren Walter, Sarah Damien.

**Welcome, Brief Introductions**

Minutes from August meeting were reviewed. Sarah D made motion to approve minutes and Milo A seconded.

- TFP/SWAT updates were shared as listed on the August agenda: there's a new SWAT Advisor at Howard Middle School; the Region 2 SWAT Training had 2 youth from Ft. King Middle School attend on behalf of Marion SWAT Chapter; suggestions were made for a community-wide GASO event—have signage created that pairs a GASO/TFP message and provide to any business that wants one (Facilitator to follow up with QuitDoc Media team and discuss); the HR Director from The Refuge was in attendance and said they are looking to do worksite wellness, wants to include GASO activities, new “smoke break” ideas were also shared that did NOT involve lighting up; Facilitator was asked to email out links to all relevant Facebook pages: TFP, Live Smoke Free, Dine Smoke Free, Marion SWAT, so that members can “Like” them and keep up to date on issues; request for link to FDA e-cig violations reporting was made—Facilitator to send out; Measure Up Marion Community Health Advocates provided an update on restaurant and smoke free multi-unit housing activities. Milo A requested designated smoking area signage that includes info on the 3 Ways to Quit—Facilitator to follow up with QuitDoc Media team.
- Advisory Council discussion: Annual Bylaw Charter update approved, Duane G moved to approve the new language, Nancy C seconded, no one opposed. Vacancy in Advisory Council discussed, Scott H made a great suggestion for a candidate—Facilitator to follow up and report on this. Point of Sale (POS) Assessment Training to be held in Quarter 2, venues were suggested—Ocala PD, StayWell; Nancy C offered to have the November CCASA meeting be this training—Facilitator following up on logistics. College of Central Florida was suggested as a partner in this assessment via the SAVA Club, request to do a POS training at one of their Monday Madness events—Facilitator to follow up.
- *Roundtable* discussion where each member, if they chose, shared in depth information about the organization that they represent and services available. Bill Cousins reported that he will be traveling to PA again for Red Ribbon Week, he has 9 venues lined up at which to speak; Suwannee River AHEC provided a list of upcoming Tools to Quit trainings happening throughout Marion County.
- Next meeting will be on October 26<sup>th</sup>, 2015 at the usual place and time, the Boys & Girls Club in Ocala starting at 3:30pm.
